Genesis 1:1-3 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. 3 And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

Psalm 35:18 KJV I will give thee thanks in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people.

Nehemiah 12:31, 40

31 I had the leaders of Judah go up on top of the wall. I also assigned two large choirs to give thanks. One was to proceed on top of the wall to the right, toward the Dung Gate. Nehemiah taught to give thanks after the completion of great undertakings.

40 The two choirs that gave thanks then took their places in the house of God; so, did I, together with half the officials,
